The Supreme Court has ordered strict nationwide enforcement of the Solid Waste Management (SWM) Rules, 2026.

In a major ruling (Bhopal Municipal Corporation v. Dr. Subhash C. Pandey), the apex court directed District Collectors to identify Bulk Waste Generators (BWGs) within six weeks and enforce source segregation. Non-compliant establishments now face severe penalties, including digital monitoring via geotagged photos and the potential disconnection of water and electricity.

The CPCB has extended the deadline (from 30 April 2026 to 30 September 2026) for filing Quarterly and Annual Returns for FY 2025–26 under the E-Waste (Management) Amendment Rules, 2024. It was done to provide additional time for businesses to complete and reconcile their E-Waste EPR reporting.

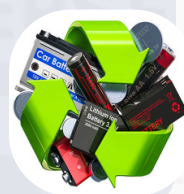
Good news for battery producers!

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) has announced an extension (till 30 November, 2026) for filing Annual Returns for FY 2025–26 under the Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022. This extension aims to give producers more time to manage operational and technical challenges in compiling and reconciling compliance data on the centralized EPR Portal.

The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has made registration on its Common EPR Portal mandatory

Registration on CPCB's Common EPR Portal is now mandatory for all eligible entities under India's PWM Rules, 2016. In accordance with Clauses 6.1 and 6.2 of the EPR Guidelines, the centralized platform tracks accountability for plastic packaging waste. Covered businesses (PIBOs) must register promptly via the official portal to ensure regulatory compliance.

CPCB has issued a Data Verification Manual for the Common EPR Portal (CEPR), covering the verification of registration, operations, and wallet data.

The CPCB has released a Data Verification Manual mandating a strict audit of data on the new Common EPR Portal (#CEPR). All registered PIBOs and PWP's must immediately verify their migrated historical registrations, annual returns, and financial year-wise transaction data. Crucially, ongoing operational access and credit wallet functionalities will remain entirely blocked until this mandatory validation checklist is fully completed and approved
